District Goals

By (May, 2018) all students will be at grade level or higher in (English/Language Arts). We will get there by increasing each student's writing:

- Writing (topic sentences and well –developed supporting details (more text-based evidence).
- Conventions (subject-verb agreement, punctuation and spelling) across all grade levels by 8% over 2 years).

By (May, 2018) , all students will be at grade level or higher in Reading we will get there by increasing each students phonic skills, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension of nonfiction text across all grade levels by 6% over 2 years.

School Goals

During the 2017-18 school year, the percentage of K-5 students meeting/exceeding standards in *Reading* at Huie Elementary School will increase by 5%, to meet the performance targets set by the state of Georgia in each grade level as measured by the *ELA Student Learning Objective (SLO)* Grades 1.

- Students will practice fluency drills at home to increase their reading ability.
- Students will practice number identification to increase their ability to recognize numbers.
- The students will practice sight words with parents each night.
- Students will complete supplemental work as needed for reading comprehension.
