Our Goals for Student Achievement

District Goals

By (May, 2018) all students will be at grade level or higher in (English/Language Arts). We will get there by increasing each student's writing:

- Writing (topic sentences and well –developed supporting details (more text-based evidence).
- Conventions (subject-verb agreement, punctuation and spelling) across all grade levels by 8% over 2 years).

By (May, 2018), all students will be at grade level or higher in Reading we will get there by increasing each students phonic skills, fluency, and comprehension of nonfiction text across all grade levels by 6% over 2 years.

By (May, 2018) all students will be at grade level or higher in Math, we will get there by increasing 3-5 student's:

 Multiplication and division within 100, addition and subtraction of fractions with like denominators, developing fractions and equivalent fractions especially fractions with numerator 1. Across all grade levels by 14% over 2 years.

School Goals

During the 2017-18 school year, the percentage of K-5 students meeting/exceeding standards in *Reading* at Huie Elementary School will increase by 5 % to meet the performance targets set by the state of Georgia in each grade level as measured by the *Student Learning Objective (SLO)* and GA Milestones.

Teachers, Parents, Students—Together for Success

In The Classroom

The 3rd grade team will work with students and their families by:

- Provide families with Reading logs
- Provide parents with multiplication practice sheets.
- Provide families with sight word practice sheets (share pair)
- Provide families with fluency/comprehension passage.

At Home

Parents will practice:

- Reading with students for 30 minutes each night and signing and returning the reading logs.
- Multiplication knowledge with students and utilize the lending library for flash cards.
- Practice Sight words at home with students.
- Ask students questions to check for comprehension.



Students

- The students will:
- Read 30 minutes each night and have parents sign off on their reading logs
- Practice multiplication utilizing flash cards and multiplication quizzes.
- Use the MyOn program at home to enhance reading.
- Practice sight word lists with parents at home.
