District Goals

By 2023, Clayton County Public Schools will increase the percentage of students scoring at the Proficient and/or Distinguished levels on the Georgia Milestones to at least 80% in each content area.



School Goals

During the 2019-20 school year, the percentage of K-5 students meeting/exceeding standards in **Reading** at Huie Elementary School will increase by 6% to meet the performance targets set by the state of Georgia in each grade level as measured by the Georgia Standards of Excellence. Kindergarten and Grade 1 will be measured through DIBELS (Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills), Grade 2 will be measured through i-Ready, Grades 3-5 will be measured through the Georgia Milestones.



In The Classroom

The Huie Elementary Team will work with students and their families by:

- Providing families with reading logs weekly.
- Providing families access to educational websites to practice reading monthly on newsletter.
- Providing a monthly log of fluency drills to help increase students reading fluency.

At Home

The Huie Elementary Team will share activities with families that can be used to help their students.

- Parents will read with students for 20 minutes each night and complete their child's reading log returning it to school by the specified date.
- Parents will use websites to let students practice reading skills.



Students

The Huie Elementary Team will make sure students complete the following:

- Students will read 20 minutes per night then have a parent or guardian sign off on their reading log.
- Students will use educational websites to practice reading
- Students will practice fluency drills at home to increase their reading fluency.
